# What does the independent living mean for us?

Samostalnost za mene znači ponovo živeti kao nekada. Personalnu asistenciju sam koristila 10 god, tako smanjila obavezu porodici (deci) oko mene.

Uz pomoć PA svaki dan sam odlazila u naše udruženje. Bila sam aktivan član Centra za samostalni život invalida. Učestvovala sam u realizaciji svih projekata. Naučila sam da radim na kompjuteru, završila sam početni kurs engleskog jezika. Prisustvovala sam na svim radionicama o samostalnom životu OSI. Na tim radionicama sam na naučila o pravima, zadacima i obavezama OSI. Obišla sam skoro celu Srbiju, manastire, izletišta, banje, učestvovala sam na sportskim takmičenjima, to sve ne bih mogla bez PA.

Zbog nedostatka finansijskih sredstava i nerazumevanja institucija koje su zadužene za OSI, Centar za samostalni život invalida u Jagodini smanjuje broj PA. Ja sam dobrovoljno odustala jer u našem udruženju ima osoba sa težim invaliditetom i njima je potrebniji PA.

Tako sam se ja ponovo vratila u neku vrstu "izolacije", i na "teret" porodice. Ne mogu kada hoću u grad, kupovinu, šetnju, kod lekara! Moram da korigujem svoje obaveze i želje po njihovom slobodnom vremenu.

For me being independent would be to live life as I lived before. I was PA user for 10 years and that was period when both my family and I live free.

With the help of PA I went to our association every day. I was an active member of CIL in Jagodina, participated in the implementation of all projects, learned to work on the computer, ended up starting an English language course, and attended all the workshops on Independent Living. At these workshops, I learned about the rights, duties and obligations of PWDs. I have visited almost all of Serbia, monasteries, resorts, SPA centers, participated in sports competitions.

Due to lack of funds and lack of understanding of local institutions responsible for PWDs, CIL in Jagodina reduces the number of PAs. I gave up voluntarily because our association has people with severe disabilities and they need PA service more than me.

So once again I returned to a kind of "isolation" and the "burden" to my family. I can not go to town when I want to, go to office, shopping and /or doctor! I need to adapt my needs and wishes to free time of my family.

For wheelchair users, independent living is simply impossible without a personal assistant. While I was on my own, my parents took me to school, to the cinema. It happened to be a great day out for a walk, and my parents were at work or tired, which meant that I could not get out.

When I got a personal assistant, it was much easier for me and for my parents.

With the support of PA, my life has become much easier, because I did not have to depend on their parents. PA helps me to do the daily

activities, getting dressed, personal hygiene, eating. ..It also helped me with the faculty, writing essays and/or exams. I started to go more often to the theater and the cinema. We also go for a walk and enjoy gatherings with friends in a coffee shops nearby.

I hope that PA service would be interested to the people, as it is very important for persons with disability and their independence.

One of the main preconditions for independent living of persons with disabilities is personal assistance service. I was lucky to participate in the project of personal assistance from the very beginning (from 2003 to 2013 with short interruptions). In the period when I was active and my life was filled. I just had an opportunity to make personal important decisions, plan my life and live it completely normal without any obstacles.

I achieved good results in table tennis, practicing daily for six hours, became a member of Serbian national team for people with disabilities, founded by table tennis club for PWDs in Jagodina, I won the October award for athlete of the year in Jagodina in 2007. Many medals from that period adorned my wall and all this I would not be able to accomplish without the support of my PA. I became an active member of CIL Jagodina, participated in various projects ... For more than three years, due to financial problems, I do not have PA and this affected the quality of my life very much. I am less active in all aspects of life.

For me, as a person with 100% physical disability, as a tenant, as a gay man, as a man who never received money as a „social case“ and do not have a pension, independent living means that I managed to organize and pay for over two decades 24/7 personal assistance every day. Independent life for me means to earn money, for personal assistants and not to live by the 'Projects', begging, to live on my family pension.

When we get out of your home, equally important would be to have an affordable automobile and accessible environment so that we can feel free to move wherever and whenever we want.

With all of the above requirements it is important to have continuing education and raising awareness of people with disabilities so that they knew how to seize all existing opportunities in a way that independent life became practice and not only the right given on paper.

Independent living means the possibility of making decisions about your life. Using the service of a personal assistant makes it easier to make choices on someone's life. Autonomy sometimes includes small, everyday, decisions such as choosing which shirt to wear today, what I'm going to have for lunch, what time I will drink tea, what time I'll go to bed ... Decisions are sometimes big ones, vital: Since I have a personal assistant I can decide to continue studies at university because I am engaging someone whose job will be to take me to class.

I will be able to apply for a job because I know there's assistant who will help me in the morning to get ready for work and accompany me to my work place, wait for me and assist me to go back. Independent Living also means that people with disabilities could spend more quality time with family and friends. This life includes daily affirmation of the dignity of persons with disabilities.

I became PA user in 2003. Member Services PA became a distant 2003. This experience was invaluable for me, because it completely changed my life. Before that, due to my injury I spent more than 20 years in home. I became active in disability movement, found ed CIL in Leskovac, at some period of time I

Postao sam trener CSŽ Srbije i održao na desetine radionica i seminara o položaju i pravima osoba sa invaliditetom, kao i o filozofiji samostalnog života OSI širom naše zemlje.

U periodu od 2007-2012. bio sam član Gradskog veća grada Leskovca, kao prva osoba sa invaliditetom i jedina vanstranačka ličnost, i dao značajan doprinos u poboljšanju položaja OSI Leskovca (stvaranje pristupačnog životnog okruženja, zapošljavanje osoba sa invaliditetom, uvođenje Usluge PA u sistem). Living my independent life I became one of CIL Serbia trainer and held dozens of workshops and seminars on the status and rights of persons with disabilities, as well as the philosophy of independent living of PWDs throughout the Serbia. In five year period (2007-2012) I was elected to the City Council of Leskovac, as first member and non-party person with a disability.

That position allowed me to made a significant contribution in improvement the situation of persons with disabilities Leskovac (creation of an accessible living environment, employment of persons with disabilities, introduction PA Services in the system). Beside more than 45 realised projects in disability field I managed to establish my graphic company. All of this I have achieved with the help of personal assistance service. Without that I would ended in some residential home. Because of that I find personal assistance service irreplaceable for independent living. Philosophy of independent living became the way of my thinking and living. There is no other way for me.

Independent living is a right of every individual to participate equally in society, working on their own development and everything which is important part of his/her being. When it comes to people with disabilities, in order to achieve something like this, it is essential that the social support, like personal assistance, should be available for, at least eight hours per day, and at least five days per week, to transform our needs in our decisions and not to depended on free time of family and friends. In a word for me to live independently represents freedom (of movement ... whenever I want ...)

Since I was twelve I started to live my life in many ways different from the one I had ever known. The concept of independence was not quite clear for me at that time, until the period of maturation and general education about my physical condition - paraplegia.

I felt independence when I first sat in a wheelchair, shaking off the bed which was so limited to me. That gave me a lot of confidence and a positive spirit. I built myself through sport and education, and even now, when I am 36 I find it necessary to keep my independence for life. It is a lifestyle and I am proud that independent living helped me to eliminate the fear of my loved ones about my future. Thanks God gave us opportunity to be independent, I would celebrate this day at least 12 times per year .

For me independent living is an opportunity to make a decision about every aspect of my life, without being limited/dependent on one's good will. Developed and permanently sustained support services are the key to this goal.

The chance that with someone's support, including personal assistant, person can use the space and time for self-organization to the maximal extent and self participation in all or some key aspects of integration within the society and the state in order to bring and apply the new values in that society.
